- (a) the progress so far made in getting a powerful transmitter from abroad for the All India Radio;

- (c) by what time it is expected to be commissioned?

THE MINISTER OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (SHRI K. K., SHAH): (a) to (c) Two very high power transmitters are being imported from abroad, for Installation near Calcutta and Rajkot. They are expected to be received in India in 1968 and will be commissioned into service in the latter half of 1968 or early in 1969.
