**REPORT ON INDIAN EDUCATION**

925. SHRI BHUPESH GUPTA: Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the Indian National Scientific Documentation Centre has been asked to give a complete report on Indian Education to the National Science Foundation of the United States of America; and

(b) if so, the reasons for taking this step?

THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION (DR. TRIGUNA SEN): (a) and (b) No, Sir, The Indian National Scientific Documentation Centre (INSDOC) is only compiling an annotated quarterly bibliography of Indian educational material from open literature in the form of books and periodical

and newspaper articles currently published in India, in accordance with a contract with the National Science Foundation, for the Department of Health, Education and Welfare, U.S.A.

**MUSEUM AT RATNAGIRI**

(a) whether Government have drawn up any scheme for developing the museum at Ratnagiri in Orissa and also the road and the bridge on the Birupa to reach this historical site:

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION (SHRI BHAGWAT JHA AZAD): (a) A scheme for the establishment of a site museum at Ratnagiri has been drawn up, but not for the development of any road or bridge to connect the site.

(b) An estimate for the construction of the site museum for Rs-1,78,060 was sanctioned in 1961 but due to emergency, construction work was suspended.

(c) Since funds are limited, priority for construction has been laid and the museum at Ratnagiri will be constructed immediately after completion of the museums at Vaishali, Lothal and Hampi.
