It is not so much the purveying of such news as the existence of Pakistan-China collusion and Pakistani assistance to Naga and Mizo hostiles which are detrimental to the growth of friendly relations between India and Pakistan.

N C C As a Reserve Trained Man-Power

*200 SHRI A G KULKARNI Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to state

(a) what is the total expense of creating a vast reserve of trained man-power in the form of National Cadet Corps, and

(b) whether the National Cadet Corps has fulfilled the expectation of feeding the regular Armed Forces with trained personnel?

THE MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SARDAR SWARAN SINGH) (a) The estimated combined expenditure incurred by the Central and State Governments on NCC during the years 1965-66 and 1966-67 was Rs 23.77 crores and Rs 25.11 crores, respectively.

(b) Aims of NCC include (i) providing service training to students so as to stimulate interest in the Defence of the country, and (ii) building up a reserve of potential manpower to enable the Armed Forces to expand rapidly in a National Emergency.

These aims by and large have been fulfilled.
