

LINKING OF WAGES WITH PRODUCTIVITY

*285. SHRI A. G. KULKARNI: Will the Minister of LABOUR AND REHABILITATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that due to fall in exports Government propose to link wages with productivity in all Industrial activities in the country; and

(b) if so, what steps Government have taken in this respect to make our 'industrial production competitive in the world market?

THE MINISTER OF LABOUR AND REHABILITATION (SHRI JAISUKH-LAL HATHI): (a) Wage fixing authorities determine wages after taking into account various factors including productivity.

(b) An economy in the earlier stages of development suffers from initial handicaps which place many of its industrial products at a competitive disadvantage as compared to the manufactures of industrially advanced countries. Government's efforts have been directed towards identifying weaknesses in the industrial structure which inhibit exports, with a view to getting them remedied in the best manner possible.

DISTRICT ADVISORY COMMITTEES

*286. SHRI R. S. KHANDEKAR: "Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether there is any proposal under Government's consideration to revive District Advisory Committees which were dispensed with after the emergency was declared; and

(b) if so, when they will be revived?

THE MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI Y. B. CHAVAN): (a) and (b) The Government of India have no such proposal under consideration. The District Advisory Committees are set up by State Governments. According to the information received so far, in Madhya Pradesh,

Bihar, West Bengal and Dadra and Nagar Haveli no District Advisory Committee was discontinued after the Proclamation of the Emergency was issued. There are no District Advisory Committees in NEFA and Mani-pur. Information from the remaining States and Union Territories is being collected and will be laid on the Table of the House.

(ग) भारत में नेपाल के राजनीतिक भू-दे की संख्या क्या है ?

•UPOLITICAL FUGITIVES PKOM NEPAL

*288. SHRI S. K. D. PALIWAL: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government have ordered the political fugitives from Nepal not to indulge in activities hostile to their country (Nepal) in India;

(b) if so, what are the contents of that order; and

(c) what is the number of political fugitives from Nepal in India?]

गृह-कार्यमंत्री (श्री दाई० बी० चव्हाण):
(क) और (ख) नेपाली राष्ट्रजनों को भारत में बिना यात्रापत्रों के प्रवेश करने की अनुमति है। अतः भारत में नेपाल से आने वाले राजनीतिक भगोड़ों का प्रश्न ही नहीं उठता और न ही भारत सरकार द्वारा ऐसा कोई आदेश जारी किया गया है जैसा प्रश्न में उल्लेख है। किन्तु सरकार नेपाली राष्ट्रजनों की किसी ऐसी राजनीतिक गतिविधि को पसन्द नहीं करती जिससे हमारे नेपाल के साथ मित्रतापूर्ण सम्बन्धों पर बुरा असर पड़े और इसलिये ऐसी गतिविधियों पर निगरानी रखी जाती है। सरकार ने नेपाली राष्ट्रजनों द्वारा निकाले जाने वाले दो समाचारपत्रों के सम्पादकों को भी चेतावनी दे दी है कि उन्हें किसी ऐसी राजनीतिक गतिविधि के लिये हमारे आतिथ्य भाव का दुरुपयोग करने की अनुमति नहीं दी जायेगी जिससे हमारे नेपाल के साथ मित्रवत् सम्बन्धों पर बुरा असर पड़े और न ही नेपाल के महाराजा के विरुद्ध व्यक्तिगत आक्रमण करने दिये जायेंगे।

(ग) भारत में नेपाली राजनीतिक कार्यकर्ताओं की संख्या लगभग 340 है।

THE MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI Y. B. CHAVAN): (a) and (b) Nepali nationals are permitted entry into India without travel

documents and hence there is no question of political fugitives from Nepal in India. Nor has any order been issued by the Government of India as stated in the question. The Government do not however approve any political activity on the part of the Nepali nationals which would prejudice our friendly relations with Nepal and vigilance is therefore maintained; for such activities. The Government have also warned editors of the two newspapers brought out by Nepali nationals, that they would not be allowed to take advantage of our hospitality to indulge in any political activity which would prejudice our friendly relations with Nepal or for making personal attacks on the King of Nepal.

(c) The number of Nepali political workers in India is approximately 340.]

(a) the number of disputes which existed between Labour and Management as on the 1st July, 1967, State-wise and what were the basic causes of these disputes; and

(b) whether Government propose to extend the recommendations made by the Royal Commission on Labour thirty years ago for the purpose of settling disputes amicably by the Railways and other industries?

THE MINISTER OF LABOUR AND REHABILITATION (SHRI JAISUKH-LAL HATHI): (a) This information is not available. The information available on the subject for the year 1966 is contained in the Appendix to Vol. I of the Annual Report of the Department of Labour for that year.
