- (b) whether the Central Silk Board has finalized a draft document on the proposed Technology Mission for silk industry and if so, whether Government have examined the same; and
  - (c) how soon the proposed Technology Mission will be launched?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF TEXTILES (SHRI E.V.K.S. ELANGOVAN): (a) to (c) Yes, Sir. The Central Silk Board is in the process of preparing a document for Technology Mission for Indian silk in consultation with various State Governments and stake holders of the industry. The document is in the initial stages and a lot of work and consultation is yet to be done. Therefore, it is not possible to tell the time of its launching at this stage.
