THE MINISTER OF INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AND COMPANY AFFAIRS (SHRI FAKHRUDDIN ALI AHMED): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The short-fall in the supplies against allotments to the Irrigation and Power projects in the year 1966-67 was due to lack of sufficient orders by the indentors as they did not have sufficient funds at their disposal and hence they could not lift the allotted quota in full.

STEEL FOR IRRIGATION PROJECTS

804. SHRI BHUPINDER SINGH: Will the Minister of STEEL, MINES AND METALS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that as against the demand of 67,464 tonnes of steel made by the Ministry of Irrigation and Power for their projects in the year 1966-67, only 40,850 tonnes of steel was supplied to them; and

(b) if so, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF STEEL, MINES AND METALS (SHRI P. C. SETHI): (a) and (b) For the year 1966-67, the demand received from the Central Water and Power Commission of the Ministry of Irrigation and Power was 81,821 tonnes, against which an allocation of 40,850 tonnes for the Water Wing and 17,610 tonnes for the Power Wing were made. The entire quantity asked for could not be allocated as the production was not sufficient to meet the full demand.
