LOSS IN DEPARTMENTAL CATERING

811. SHRI TRILOKI SINGH: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) the losses incurred by the Railways on departmental catering during the past five years; and

(b) the reasons for not entrusting the catering to private vendors or agencies and keep a check over them to ensure quality and regular supply by prescribing menus and fixing up prices?

THE MINISTER OF RAILWAYS (SHRI C. M. POONACHA): (a) Audited figures of Profit/Loss on departmental catering for 5 years from 1961-62 to 1965-66 are given below:—

(b) Departmental catering was introduced on the Railways, to a limited extent, on the basis of the recommendations of the Alagesan Committee with a view to improve standards. A high level committee including Members of Parliament has now been appointed to review the position and go into the relative merits of contract and departmental catering.
