**POST-GRADUATE COURSES IN DELHI COLLEGES**

(b) whether it has come to the notice of the University Grants Commission that in certain colleges no regular student has been able to pass these examinations for the last few years?

(b) The Delhi University has informed that some colleges for some years had sent a very small number of students in particular examinations at the M.A. level and all of them failed; although this does not appear to have come to the notice of the University Grants Commission.
