भोजन की बिक्री पर बेचरों को जो कमीशन दी जाती है, उसकी दर स्थानीय परिस्थितियों के आधार पर रेल प्रशासन तय करते हैं और यह प्रति प्लेट के आधार पर न होकर प्रति कपड़ा 8 पैसे से लेकर 20 पैसे तक भिन्न-भिन्न होती है। बेचरों को दी जाने वाली कमीशन की दर में 15 मई, 1967 से कोई परिवर्तन नहीं किया गया है।

STATEMENT

Reduction in bearers' commission in departmental catering

(a) to (c) No Sir. In 1957, on Railways other than Southern, the standard charges for vegetarian and non-vegetarian meals served in train compartments were Re. 1.00 and Rs. 1.25 for service from refreshment rooms and Rs. 1.12 and Rs. 1.37 for service in and from dining cars. The corresponding charges on the Southern Railway were Re. 0.81 and Re. 1.00 for service from refreshment rooms and Re. 0.87 and Rs. 1.06 for service in and from dining cars.

The charges for vegetarian and non-vegetarian meals were last revised with effect from 15th May, 1967 and not from 15th June, 1967, the rates being Rs. 1.30 and Rs. 1.80 respectively for all Railways when served in Refreshment rooms. A service charge of 0.50 paise per meal is levied when the meal is served in a dining car or in a train compartment.

The charges mentioned above are exclusive of sales-tax, which is leviable in addition.

The rates of commission paid to bearers on the sales of meals are fixed by Railway Administrations, depending upon local conditions and vary from 8 to 20 paise per rupee and not per plate. There has been no change in the rates of commission paid to bearers from 15th May, 1967.]
