THE MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS <SHRI Y. B. CHAVAN): (a) The list of private properties furnished by the late Nizam of Hyderabad Twas examined by the then Hyderabad Government and finalised by the Government of India in consultation with them.

(b) The net wealth assessed under the Wealth-Tax Act for the assess ment year 1957-58 was about Rs. 10 crores. The assessments for subsequent years have not yet been finalised.

THE MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI Y. B. CHAVAN): ra) Yes, Sir. On the outbreak of hostilities between India and Pakistan in August-September, 1965 all properties and assets of Indian nationals' firms and institutions in Pakistan were seized by the Government of Pakistan under the Defence of Pakistan Rules.

to Ouestions

- fb) No, Sir. In accordance with Article 8 of the Tashkent Declaration, the Government of India have made repeated attempts to discuss this question with the Government of Pakistan in order to secure the release of the seized properties and assets of Indian nationals. The Government of Pakistan have made no favourable response to our proposals to far.
- (c) The Government of India are continuing their efforts to secure the return of these properties.
