An Indian national was, however, arrested in that district on 5th May, 1967 in suspicious circumstances. The case is still under investigation.]

(c) Adequate machinery exists for countering the activities of spies in the country, particularly in the sensitive border areas.]

ADDITIONAL HELP TO MADHYA PRADESH FOR COMPULSORY PRIMARY EDUCATION

298. SHRI K. C. BAGHEL: Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government of Madhya Pradesh approached the Central Government for an additional help for the development of compulsory primary education during 1966-67; and

(b) if so, what action has been taken thereon?

THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION (DR. TRIGUNA SEN): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The entire provision for enrolment of additional children in the Fourth Plan has been placed in the State Sector and there is no separate provision in the Central Sector for assisting backward States.

ASSISTANCE FOR MULTI-PURPOSE SCHOOLS IN M.P.

299. SHRI K. C. BAGHEL: Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether any financial assistance was given to the Government of Madhya Pradesh for multi-purpose schools during the Third Five Year Plan period; and

(b) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION (DR. TRIGUNA SEN): (a) Yes, Sir. Central assistance amounting to Rs. 2,42,686 was released to the State Government during the Third Plan.
