

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI K. S. RAMASWAMY): (a) to (c) The sale proceeds of the Store at Raisina Road were somewhat lower in the half-year ending June, 1967, as compared to the corresponding periods in 1966 and 1965. This is because with the introduction of rationing in December, 1965, and the opening of 13 new Branch Stores in the various localities, the members who used to make purchases from the Raisina Road Store started patronising the Branch Stores nearer their homes. While there is no reason to believe that the Stores are becoming unpopular, efforts are being made to step up the sales.

ADMISSION IN DELHI COLLEGES

293. SHRI BHUPINDER SINGH: SHRI CHITTA BASU:

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

(a) the number of students course-wise who registered their names for admission to the first year of the 3 year degree course this year in colleges in Delhi;

(b) the number of those admitted, course-wise; and

(c) the steps taken to accommodate the students who are eligible for admission but have not so far been admitted?

THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION (DR. TRIGUNA SEN): (a) and (b) The number of those who registered, and number of those who were admitted till July 24, 1967 is as below:—

(c) Admissions have also been made after July 24 and for some of the courses are still in progress. All those who registered have not turned up for admission, because some of them may have got admission in Technical and other institutions. For example, all the eligible 1,080 students who registered for B.Sc. (Hons.) Courses were notified of their admission. But, only 657 paid their fees till 24-7-1967. Similarly in B.A. (Pass) course some seats have remained vacant. The University is making efforts to provide maximum number of seats to eligible candidates by expanding the existing facilities wherever feasible except in the Pre-Medical course where on academic grounds the University is not in favour of increasing the seats.

294. श्री सुन्दर सिंह भंडारी : क्या गृह-कार्य मंत्री यह बताने की कृपा करेंगे कि :

(क) भारत-पाकिस्तान संघर्ष के समय सीमा पार कर पाकिस्तान चले जाने वाले ऐसे लोगों की संख्या कितनी है जिन्हें अपने घरों को लौट आने की अनुमति दे दी गई है;

(ख) सरकार द्वारा इन घर लौटने वाले लोगों के साथ घुसपैठियों को भारत में प्रविष्ट होने से रोकने के लिये क्या प्रबन्ध किये गये हैं; और

(ग) पाकिस्तानी घुसपैठियों के पक्ष में किये गये प्रदर्शनों के विरुद्ध क्या कार्यवाही की गई है?
