

(d) whether any step has been taken to construct power stations by-adopting precast pattern?

THE MINISTER OF IRRIGATION AND POWER (DR K. L. RAO): (a) and (b) Yes.

(c) Five Working Groups have been set up by the Central Board of Irrigation and Power to consider the question of Standardisation of heavy electrical equipment. It has also been decided by the Central Board of Irrigation and Power to set up a special committee to examine the question of standardisation in civil engineering structures.

(d) In certain Thermal Power Stations constructed in India with Soviet assistance, the Soviet pattern of precast construction has been partially adopted. This pattern is likely to be adopted in some more Thermal Power Stations to be taken up in the Fourth Plan.

#### L.I.C. HOUSE

231. SHRI R. P. KHAITAN: Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Life Insurance Corporation has constructed some houses for sale to the public in 1966; and

(b) if so, how much amount was spent on the construction of such houses and what are the sale proceeds of those houses?

THE DEPUTY PRIME MINISTER AND MINISTER OF FINANCE (SHRI MORARJI R. DESAI): (a) No, Sir. The L.I.C. has not constructed any houses for sale to the public, but has sold some properties inherited by it from private Insurance Companies.
