(b) if so, what is the amount of the compensation that has been realised and if not; what are the reasons therefor?]

DEVELOPMENT OF NARMADA VALLEY

\*313. RAJA SHANKAR PRATAP SINGH: Will the Minister of PLANNING, PETROLEUM AND CHEMICALS AND SOCIAL WELFARE be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the Planning Commission has agreed to some financial provision being made for Narmada Valley Development in the Fourth Five Year Plan of Gujarat; and

(b) if so, what are the details of the basis on which the provision is proposed to be made?

THE MINISTER OF PLANNING, PETROLEUM AND CHEMICALS AND SOCIAL WELFARE (SHRI ASOKA MEHTA): (a) and (b) Government of Gujarat had proposed some financial provision for the Narmada project at Navagam in their Fourth Plan proposals. During discussions between the Planning Commission and the State Government, tentative conclusions were reached as to the overall allocation for the Major and Medium Irrigation programmes in the State. The scheme-wise details of this allocation have not yet

been furnished by the State Government and it is not therefore possible to say what amount they propose to spend on the Navagam project.

Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

(a) whether some of the former Auditor Generals of India are holding offices under the Union or the State Governments; and

(b) if so, whether Government will be pleased to lay a list containing the names of such persons on the Table of the House?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI K. C. PANT): (a) No, Sir. According to the Constitution of India, a retired Comptroller and Auditor General is not eligible for such office.

(b) if so, what action has been taken by the Life Insurance Corporation thereon?

THE DEPUTY PRIME MINISTER AND MINISTER OF FINANCE (SHRI MORARJI R. DESAI): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The Life Insurance Corporation does not propose to take any action on the said charter as the said Union is not recognised under the Code of Discipline.

SUICIDE PREVENTION CENTRES

(a) whether it is a fact that proposals are being finalised to start Suicide Prevention Centres in India on the model of "Save a life" Society in the United States; and

(b) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL WELFARE (DR. SHRIMATI PHULRENU GUHA): (a) and (b) No such proposal is under consideration.
