†[THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI VIDYA CHARAN SHUKLA):

(a) Yes, Sir.

(b) On the 13th December, 1966 at about 6.30 P.M. a gang of 70/80 armed Naga hostiles raided the Serou Bazar from three directions by opening fire at random, burnt down three houses, looted one shop and carried away money and property worth about Rs. 15,000. They also assaulted five persons. A case has been registered under section 436 IPC and four persons have so far been arrested. To prevent recurrence of such incidents, a police outpost has been opened on 28th January, 1967 near Serou.]

SUSPENSION OF THE BOOKING OF ORDINARY TELEGRAMS IN NEW DELHI

278. SHRI A. D. MANI: Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that Government issued instructions on or about the Republic Day this year for suspending the booking of ordinary telegrams in New Delhi; and

(b) if so, what were the reasons for the same?

(b) Because the telegraphists suddenly, absented on 24th, 25th and 26th January, 1967 *en-masse*.

PAK INFILTRATION INTO ASSAM

280. SHRI N. R. MUNISWAMY: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that infiltration of Pakistanis into Assam continues unabated and its rate has shot up after a marked decline in the last two months;

(b) whether it is a fact that during the first week of January, 1967, 53 infiltrators were apprehended in Darrang district alone; and

(c) whether it is a fact that in the last quarter of 1966 about 1000 infiltrators were detected?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI VIDYA CHARAN SHUKLA): (a) No, Sir.

(b) The number detected was 58. Of these, 23 were infiltrators and the remaining 35 had overstayed their visas.

(c) The number actually detected was 1303.
