

ESCAPE OF MIZO HOSTILES FROM JAIL,

*359. PT. BHAWANIPRASAD TIWARY: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) what were the circumstances in which twenty Mizo hostiles were able to escape from the Aijal Jail which is situated in the heart of the city; and

(b) whether a detailed enquiry has been held into the incident; and if so, what is the outcome thereof?]

1967 की रात को 20 बन्दी कपड़ों को बट
कर उनकी सहायता से ऐजल की जेल की
दीवार फांद कर भाग निकले। सुरक्षा सैनिकों
की कार्यवाहियों के फलस्वरूप बहुत बड़ी
संख्या में मिजो विद्रोही पकड़े गये
हैं और उक्त जेल में उस समय बहुत अधिक
भीड़ थी।

(ख) राज्य सरकार ने विस्तृत जांच
का आदेश दे दिया है। प्रतिवेदन की प्रतीक्षा
की जा रही है।

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE

night of 6/7th March, 1967, twenty prisoners
escaped from the Jail at Aijal by scaling the
wall with the help of cloth strung together.
Due to operations by the Security Forces, a
large number of Mizo rebels have been
captured and the jail was at that time
overcrowded.

(b) The State Government have ordered
detailed investigation. The report is awaited.]
