SHRI BHAGWAT JHA AZAD: Sir, in 1965-66 we have already a pilot plant producing about 1.5 to 2 tons per day of coal fertiliser, but that is not the point. The point is that scientific data are still being gathered on a large scale. We have established it on a small scale but unless we can produce it on a large scale, we cannot commend it for commercial use.

श्री विमतकुनार मञ्जालालजी चौरिड्या: व्या श्रीमान यह बतायेंगे कि जो रसायन विभाग के मंत्रों हैं, उनका यह कहना है कि कोल बेंस्ड फर्टिलाइजर्स के जो प्लांट होते हैं, वें नेप्या बेंस्ड फर्टिलाइजर्स के प्लान्ट के मुकाबिल में मंहगे पड़ते हैं और अन्य देशों के अनुभव के आधार पर उनका ऐसा कहना है कि इस कोल बेंस्ड फर्टिलाइजर्स के प्लान्ट को प्राथमिकता नहीं दो जा रही है, तो क्या इस रिसर्च में हम ऐसी बात खोज रहे हैं कि जिन्होंने कोल बेंस्ड फर्टिलाइजर्स को छोड़ना आरम्भ कर दिया है, उनसे हम चीप इसको तैयार कर सकेंगे या उसके लिये हमने दूसरा मैथड निकाला है ?

श्री भागवत झा आजाद: ग्रापने जिस प्रश्न का उल्लेख किया है, यह ठीक है कि अमेरिका जैसे देश में कोयले के आधार पर जो प्लान्ट हैं, उनको जगह उन्होंने दूसरे प्लान्ट प्रारम्भ किये हैं। लेकिन अभी हमारी लेबोरैंटरी में जो अनुसंधान हो रहा है, उसके आधार पर हम कह सकते हैं कि जहां तक हमको खबर मिलो है, उसके अनुसार बह उसकी तुलना में सस्ता पड़ेगा। इसलिये हम इस एक्सपेरिमेंट को जाशी रखना चाहते हैं।

श्रो तिरंजन वर्मा: क्या श्रीमान यह बताने का कष्ट करेंगे कि मध्य प्रदेश में चिरमिरी ग्रादि स्थानों में जहां कोयले की खानें ग्रधिक हैं, वहां पर इस प्रकार का कोई प्रयोग किया जा रहा है ग्रौर ग्रगर प्रयोग नहीं किया जा रहा है, तो क्या वहां पर भी प्रयोग किया जाने वाला है ? श्री भागवत झा श्राजाद : श्रभी तो हम इसका प्रयोग सेंट्रल प्युश्रल रिसर्च इस्टिट्यूट में कर रहे हैं और जो हमारे सामने खबर बार्ड है, उसके श्रनुसार हमने उन स्थानों पर प्रयोग किया है, जहां यह सम्भव है कि उबर्रक से लाभ होगा । आर्थिक ढंग पर जब बड़े पैमाने पर इसका बनाना सिद्ध हो जायेगा, तब हम मध्य प्रदेश या और प्रदेशों में जा सकते हैं।

- (a) the progress since made in connection with the setting up of the Hindi Teachers Training College in. Trivandrum in July, 1967;
- (b) whether any building for the College has now been procured; and
- (c) whether the Government of Kerala have given am\* assurance that the College would start functioning in July, 1967?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION (PROF. SHER SINGH); (a) Necessary steps have been taken for the appointment of teaching and ministerial staff, purchase of Educational appliances and office equipment, book. 1? for Library etc.

- (b) The State Government is on the look out for a suitable building for the College and hopes to secure It by May or June, 1967.
  - (c) Yes, Sir.

SHRI M. P. BHARGAVA: May I know whether the .Minister is in a position to assure us that this college will start in July 1967 and it will not meet the same fate as it met last year? It was to start according to the original programme, in July 1966 but th®

State Government did not take adequate steps. May I know from the hon. Minister whether he has ascertained that necessary adequate steps are being taken to see that the college functions from July?

PROF. SHER SINGH: It is true that this was to start in July, 1966 but there were certain difficulties. One was with regard . . .

MR. CHAIRMAN:  $H_e$  only wants to know whether you have the same difficulty this year.

PROF. SHER SINGH: This year everything is being done; we are selecting the staff, etc. It will start in July 1967.

## RETIREMENT OF GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES AFTER 25 YEARS OF SERVICE

•347. SHRI N. R. MUNISWAMY: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether there is any proposal under consideration' by the Govern-

ment to retire Government employees who have completed 25 years of service or have reached the age t>f 50 without giving any reason and without liability for special pension; and

(b) if so, whether the proposal covers posts in the scientific, technical and managerial fields also?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI VIDYA CHARAN SHUKLA): (a) and (b): The matter is under consideration.

SHRI N. R. MUNISWAMY: Sir, this matter has been under consideration for over six to seven months. It came once or twice before the Cabinet but they have referred it back, saying it will be taken up after the elections. I do not know the actual thinking of the Government in regard to this matter, because the man gets efficient only at the age of 50. If he is retired at the age of 50, that will mean displacing efficient persons in service. Therefore, I would like to know if there are any objections from the Finance Ministry and, if so, what is the reason assigned by the Finance Ministry in order to implement this?

SHRI VIDYA CHARAN SHUKLA: No, Sir. There is no obstruction from the Finance Ministry, as far as this matter is concerned but, as Members will realise, it is a very complicated matter and very great thought has to be given to it before this is finalised.

SHRI NIREN GHOSH: Sir, a man is generally capable of active service at least up to the age of 55 years. So, will not this proposal cut off a large number of men from their sources of income? May I know whether this fact also will be taken into consideration by the Government, that a large number of persons will be affected if their retirement is to be at 50?

SHRI VIDYA CHARAN SHUKLA: Sir, this is mainly with regard to
