NATIONAL COMMISSION ON LABOUR

169. SHRI BABUBHAI M. CHINAI: Will the Minister of LABOUR AND REHABILITATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether any representations have been received by Government against the composition of the National Commission on Labour; and

(b) if so, from whom the representations have been received and what are the main objections contained therein?

THE MINISTER OF LABOUR AND REHABILITATION (SHRI JAI-SUKHLAL HATHI): (a) Yes.

(b) Oral representations were made in February 1967 to the then Labour Minister jointly by (i) the Employers' Federation of India and (ii) the All India Organisation of Industrial Employers about the inadequacy of employers' representation on the National Commission on Labour. Written requests were also received from (i) the All India Manufacturers Organisation and (ii) the Federation of Association of Small Industries for a representation on the Commission.
