THE MINISTER OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI M. C. CHAGLA)-(a) and (b) India alongwith almost all other member States of the United Nations has appealed to U Thant to accept a further term as U. N. Secretary-General. The present position is that, with U Thar.t's consent his term has been extended till the conclusion of the 'XXI Session of the General Assembly. U Thant has not announced his decision as to whether in response to the requests made to him to continue as Secretary-General, he would be willing to continue thereafter as Secretary-General.
