

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (DR. RAM SUBHAG SINGH): (a) and (b) On 16th September, 1966, No. 122 Up Tiruchirappalli-Reni-gunta Fast Passenger scheduled to halt at Kuttalam did not stop at its normal place due to miscalculation by the Driver. The train was, however, brought to a halt after the engine and first two bogies had passed the Down Home Signal by the application of the vacuum brakes by the Guard. The passengers bound for Kuttalam station then detrained, and the train was restarted without backing to the station, with the result that four passengers waiting at the station to catch this train could not do so. Staff held responsible for this lapse are being suitably taken up.
