- (3)  $I_n$  the field of technical education the manpower requirements of the fourth and subsequent plans should be assessed carefully and the admissions to the courses should be suitably altered to meet the needs of the economic development.
- (4) The Ministry of Education should examine, in consultation with the Ministry of Defence, the program-

(5) To secure community participation in a big way for improving physical facilities in schools, a concerted nation-wide effort should be made on the lines of the School Improvement Programme in Madras.

Other recommendations are still under consideration.
