SATELLITE COMMUNICATIONS EARTH STATION

272. SHRI A. D. MANI: SHRI N. PATRA:

Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

(a) whether a satellite communications earth station is proposed to be set up near Ahmedabad in August, 1967; and

(b) if so, what are the details 61 the project?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF ATOMIC ENERGY (SHRI M. S. GURUPADASWAMY): (a) and (b) Yes, Sir. The Department is setting up an Experimental Satellite Communication Earth Station at Ahmedabad. The Station will be a Centre for research and training in the technology of satellite communication. The United Nations Special Fund is contributing the cost of the main equipment for the Station. The rest of the work, including the construction of buildings, is being undertaken by the Department Of Atomic Energy. The Station is expected to become operational by August 1967.

MINISTER'S VISIT TO KUWAIT

273. SHRI RAM CHANDER: SHRI V. V. RAMASWAMY:

Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether he led a delegation to Kuwait and other countries recently; and

(b) if so, what agreements|arrange-ments| were finalised to increase and strengthen India's relations including trade $a^{n\leq *}$ cultural relations, with these coutries?

THE MINISTER OF EXTERNAL. AFFAIRS (SHRI M. C. CHAGLA): (a) and (b) I have already made a Statement on the Floor of the House on 22nd May, 1967 about my recent visit to Kuwait, Iran, Geneva, Malaysia and Singapore. This statement coers the points raised in the Question.

SITUATION IN VIETNAM

274. SHRI RAM CHANDER: Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Prime Minister availed of the opportunity provided by the U. N. Secretary-General's, visit to New Delhi recently to discuss proposals and prospects for revival of peace talks in Vietnam and to bring the two sides to the Vietnam conflict to the conference table; and

(b) what other steps have bees, taken by the Government of India to achieve this objective during the past two months?

THE MINISTER OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI M. C. CHAGLA) (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The Government of India is in touch with other Governments, as also with the Secretary-General of the United Nations, in its efforts te help find a peaceful solution of the Vietnam problem. At this stage it would not be proper to disclose the nature and content of these contacts which ar_e of a confidential nature.

EXPANSION AND SETTING UT OF T. V. UNITS IN DELHI, CHANDIGARH AND AMRITSAR, ETC.

275. SHRI JAGAT NARAIN: Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING be please to state:

(a) whether proposals to expand the T. V. Unit in Delhi and to set up of T. V. Units at Chandiarh, Amritsar, Jullundur and Ambala have bees finalised by Government;

(b) if so, the details thereof; and

(c) whether any foreign collaboration ha_s been accepted by Government for the expansion of the television system in the country.
