THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY PLANNING (DR. S. CHAN-DRASEKHAR): (a) Yes.

(b) During the current year, a request had been made to the Government of U.S.S.R. for the supply 8.25 million doses of freeze-dried small-pox vaccine on an emergent basis. Against this, 6.60 million doses have been received so far. As a long term measure, a request has made for the supply of 100 million doses per year for three to In the earlier years, 650 million doses of the vaccine had received from the U.S.S.R. in three instalments of 250, 200 and 200 million doses as per our request.
