THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI K. C. PANT): No, Sir, No new posts of Book Binders were created from 1966 onwards in the National Archives of India under the Ministry of Education or in the External Publicity Press under the Ministry of External Affairs in which offices revision of pay scales was not agreed to.
