

**AFRO-ASIAN SCIENCE SYMPOSIUM**

\*65. SHRI RAM SINGH: Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that Government have sanctioned a sum of Rs. 8 lakhs for holding an Afro-Asian Science Symposium at Delhi in the month of April, 1966; and

(b) if so, whether the symposium was held as per schedule; and if so, the number of countries which had participated in that symposium?

THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION (SHRI M.C. CHAGLA): (a) No, Sir, a sum of Rs. 4 lakhs only was given to the Association of Scientific Workers of India for holding the Symposium.

(b) Yes, Sir, the Symposium was held from the 25th April to 2nd May, 1966, as scheduled. Thirty-four countries (including India) participated in the Symposium.

**INTEGRATION OF JAMMU AND KASHMIR WITH THE INDIAN UNION**

\*66. SHRI S. S. N. TANKHA: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether any further steps have been taken by the Government recently for the complete integration of the State of Jammu and Kashmir with the Indian Union; and if so, what; and

(b) by when it is proposed to abrogate Article 370 of the Indian Constitution?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS: (SHRI JAISUKHLAL HATHI): (a) Provisions of the Constitution are being progressively applied to the State of Jammu and Kashmir with the consent of the State Government. Attention is invited to Presidential Orders under Article 370 of the Constitution issued on the 17th May and 24th November, 1965.

(b) There is no such proposal.
