EXISTENCE OF IRON, SULPHUR AND OIL IN GULF OF CAMBAY

- $\bullet 934.$ SHRI M. C. SHAH : Will the Minister of MINES AND METALS be pleased to state :
- (a) whether it is a fact that Indian and French scientists have ascertained that there is iron and sulphur in the Gulf of Cambay in addition to oil; and
 - (b) if so, the details in this regard?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF MINES AMD METALS (SYED AHMED MEHDI): (a) and (b) The hon. Member is presumably referring to the seismic surveys carried out in the

off-shore region of the Gulf of Cambay by Russian seismic crew and technicians. No French scientists were associated in these oflf-shoie investigations. The final result of the surveys which are still in progress will not be available until about the middle of 1967. There is no present information about iron and sulphur, in the Guli of Cambay, besides oil.

SHRI M. C. SHAH: May I know whether any assessment has been made about the nature of these deposits in the team and what will be the cost of taking them out and how will they compare with the existing market prices?

SYED AHMED MEHDI: As I have said Sir, the survey is still going on and we will not have the report till the end of 1967

SHRI M. C. SHAH: May I know whether these sc.entists have obtained ^formation regarding the Indian Ocean and the i Arabian Sea ?

SYED AHMED MEHDI: Not yet. They are only doing the survey along the west coast

SHRI M. C. SHAH: May I know whether the scientists have opined that as a result of the working of the atomic reactor near Bombay the radio-active matter that will be released in the sea will create a new and difficult problem for India?

SYED AHMED MEHDI : We have no information about it.

SHRI M. M. DHARIA: May we know whether the Ministry has got any schemes or plans about the surveys that are made in the country or whether the surveys are carried out only at the instance of the State Governments?

SHRI S. K. DEY: The Geological Survey of India is a national institution re ponsi-ble for mapping out underground materials • and underground ores all over the country.
