THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND
FAMILY PLANNING (DR SUSHILA
NAYAR): (a) Yes.

(b) During the period 1st October, 1965 to
9th February, 1966, 190 prosecutions under
the Prevention of Food Adulteration Act, and
634 under the Punjab Municipal Act were
launched by the N. D. M. C. against hawkers
dealing in foodstuffs.
