#### AID INDIA CONSORTIUM

\*49. SHRI RAMGOPAL GUPTA: Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

(a) whether the member-countries of the Aid India Consortium which had suspended or curtailed aid to India during the recent Indo-Pakistani conflict, have since resumed the aid; and

(b) if so, what is the present position in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF FINANCE (SHRI SACHINDRA CHAUDHUR)

(a) and (b) Action with member

countries of the Aid India Consortium other than the United States is on hand in the normal manner to implement the offers of aid made in 1965. So far as the United States is concerned, after the commencement of the Indo-Pakistani hostilities, we were informed of a special procedure under which prior consultation with members of the US Congress was needed before any new commitment of aid was made. In his message to the US Congress on February 1, 1966 the US President has said that aid (other than food) to both India and Pakistan will remain suspended till there is reasonable certainty that hostilities between the two countries will not recur; he has further said:—"The progress of reconciliation—first at the United Nations and then at Tashkent—holds promise that these two great countries have resolved on a course of peace. My request for development loan funds is made in the hope and belief that this promise will be fulfilled." It must be noted that two new loans have been made to India by US Agencies recently: one of \$ 50 million for the import of fertilisers from the USA and the other of \$ 3.34 million for Capital equipment required by Messrs. Hardillia Chemicals.
