(b) Preliminary discussions with the U.P. Government for providing land for the above two laboratories have been held. No final decision has yet been taken on these laboratories.

WORKERS OF DELHI CLOTH MILLS

637. SHRI S. C. DEB: Will the Minister of LABOUR, EMPLOYMENT AND REHABILITATION be pleased to state the terms under which the workers of the Delhi Cloth Mills have joined work and what is the settlement arrived at with the management?

THE MINISTER OF LABOUR, EM-PLOYMENT AND REHABILITATION (SHRI JAGJIVAN RAM): Resumption of work was not in pursuance of any settlement reached with the management. The management lifted the lock-out on the night of 4th March, 1966 and the workers resumed work after an order was issued under Section 10(3) of the Industrial Disputes Act, prohibiting the continuance of lock-out as well as strike. The dispute has been referred to an Industrial Tribunal for adjudication.
