

गृह-कार्य मंत्रालय में राज्य मंत्री (श्री जयसुख लाल हाथी) : प्रथम अप्रैल से 31 दिसम्बर, 1965 तक की अवधि में विशेष पुलिस संस्थान ने 248 मामले न्यायालयों में चलाये। इस अवधि में न्यायालयों ने 153 मामलों में निर्णय दिये, जिनमें से 128 में दोष सिद्ध हुए, तथा 25 में अभियुक्त बरी हुए।

इसी अवधि में 1027 मामले विशेष पुलिस संस्थान ने विभागीय कार्यवाही के लिये भेजे। 735 मामलों में निर्णय किये गये, जिनमें से 637 में विभागीय दण्ड दिये गये, तथा 98 में दोषमुक्त किये गये।

†[THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI JAISUKHLAL HATHI): 248 cases were put in courts by the Special Police Establishment during the period 1st April to 31st December, 1965. During this period 153 cases were decided by courts of which 128 ended in conviction and 25 in acquittal.

During the same period, 1027 cases were referred by the Special Police Establishment for departmental action. 735 cases were decided, of which 637 ended in departmental punishment and 98 in exoneration.]
