(a) the present number of community polytechnics set up by the Central Government;

(b) the location of these polytechnics;

(c) whether Government propose to go for a massive increase in the number of community polytechnics;

(d) if so, the number of such polytechnics proposed to be set up during the current financial year; and

(e) the main objectives of increasing the number of community polytechnics?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DR. MURLI MANOHAR JOSHI): (a) Five hundred and sixteen (516).

(b) The State-wise position is given in the Statement (*See below*).

(c) and (d) It is proposed to set up 101 new community polytechnics during the current financial year (2000-2001).

(e) The main objective is to impart non-formal training in various need based skills to rural youth, women and other disadvantaged section of the society in order to make them self employable/ wage employable.
