DASARINARAYANA RAO: Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to refer to answer to Unstarred Question 1455, given in Rajya Sabha on 4th August, 2000 and state how many towns and cities covered under Urban Malaria Scheme (UMS) are located in Andhra Pradesh, with details of each town/city?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE [DR. (SHRIMATI) RITA VERMA]: In Andhra Pradesh, 8 Towns/Cities namely Hyderabad, Guntur, Vishakhapatnam, Warangal, Khammam, Nalgonda, Kurnool and Vijayawada are covered under Urban Malaria Scheme (UMS).
