Engineering Research Institute, Pilani and the Development Commissioner, Small Scale Industries are helping in the designing of the prototype. As soon as the design is finalised, manufacture will start and the price of the radio is expected to be round Rs. 81 each.

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE (SHRI M. SHAFI QURESHIJ: Devaluation will make the prices of Indian tea in foreign markets more competitive. It is not possible, however, to estimate the precise extent to which tea exports will increase. The prospects of increase in tea exports depend more on production, internal consumption and surplus available.
