

**THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION**  
(SHRI M. C. CHAGLA) : (a) and (b) Yes, Sir.

(c) The duration of LL.B. Course for the day and the evening scholars has been prescribed by the University on the basis of the recommendation of a Committee headed by the then Chief Justice of India Shri P. B. Gajendragadkar to the effect that in order to prevent deterioration of standards in the evening classes where students will not be in a position to devote as much time to their studies as will be required of the day scholars under the new courses, which are recognisedly far heavier than the courses taught hitherto, the evening students should be required study for four years. This will enable the Course to be distributed less intensely for them and in such a way that they can cope with it. The Bar Council of India have also made rules that no person shall be eligible for enrolment under the Advocates Act, 1961 unless he has done a course of instruction in Law, whose duration is three years for full-time pupils and four years for part-time pupils.

There is, therefore, no question of discrimination in the matter.

#### CONTROL OVER PRIVATE EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS

(SHRI M. C. CHAGLA) : (a) and (b) A model Bill has been prepared and sent to the State Governments for necessary action and comments thereon, if any. The question of enacting this measure in respect of the Union Territories is under consideration.

(b) The Bill aims at regulating the establishment, maintenance and activities of private (unrecognised) educational institutions preparing students for recognised degrees, diplomas and certificates.
