The joint communique issued at the end of the meeting stressed the need for more active and fruitful cooperation among participating countries in "the economic, technical, cultural, social and information fields". The Communique also referred to political questions like those of Vietnam and Korea generally supporting the stand taken by the Republic of Vietnam and the Republic of Korea,

ARMS AID TO INDIA

454. SHRI ABDUL GHANI: SHRI M. S. OBEROI:

Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to state:

- (a) the names of the countries which have relaxed restrictions regarding the supply of arms and ammunitions to India after the Tashkent Declaration; and
- (b) the names of the countries which have not lifted embargo on defence supplies to India?

THE MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SHRIY. B. CHAVAN): (a) and (b) After the Tashkent Declaration, U.K. and France have lifted completely the restrictions on supply of arms and ammunition to India and West Germany and Switzerland have lifted them partly. U.S.A. has relaxed the embargo in respect of non-lethal defence supplies.

MAURITIUS DEMAND FOR INDEPENDENCE

- (c) whether it is proposed to raise this question at the next ensuing Commonwealth Prime Ministers' Conference?
