WORK DONE BY THE COMMISSIONER FOR PUBLIC GRIEVANCES

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI JAISUKHLAL HATHI): Apart from co-ordinating and keeping under review the work of the Complaints Officers in the various Ministries/Departments in connection with redressal of grievances the Commissioner for Public Grievances had received direct from the public 845 complaints till the end of August 1966. Out of these he has by now dealt with 581 complaints. The remaining are at differ-rent stages of action in consultation with the Ministries/Departments concerned.

A detailed report on the working of the arrangements in the Ministries/Departments for the redressal of public grievances is under preparation and will be submitted to Government shortly.
