†[PUTTING UP OF FIRST CLASS RESERVATION LIST IN RESPECT OF TRAIN RUNNING BETWEEN DELHI AND BOMBAY

644. SHRI V. M. CHORDIA: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state the reasons for not putting up the reservation list at the places meant for the purpose and also on the coach itself in respect of the reservations in the first class compartments of 19-UP train running between Delhi and Bombay?]

रेल मंत्रालय में राज्य मंत्री (डा० राम सुभग सिंह) : संभवतः आशय 20-अप देहरादून एक्सप्रेस गाड़ी से है जो दिल्ली के रास्ते देहरादून और बम्बई के बीच चलती है। देहरादून और बम्बई सेंट्रल स्टेशन के बीच चलने वाले डिब्बों के अलावा इस गाड़ी में दिल्ली में से कुछ सेक्शनल डिब्बे भी लगाये जाते हैं। दिल्ली से चलने वाले यात्रियों के लिए जो आरक्षण किये जाते हैं उनके आरक्षण चार्ट आरक्षण चार्ट बोर्डों पर लगा दिये जाते हैं। दिल्ली से जो सेक्शनल डिब्बे लगाये जाते हैं, उन पर पहले ही लेबुल लगा दिये जाते हैं और देहरादून से चलने वाले डिब्बों पर लेबुल गाड़ी के दिल्ली में स्टेशन पहुंचने के बाद लगाये जाते हैं।

†[THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (DR. RAM SUBHAG SINGH): Presumably, the reference is to 20-UP Dehra Dun Express train running between Dehra Dun and Bombay via Delhi. Apart from the train service coaches running between Dehra Dun and Bombay Central Station some Sectional Coaches are also attached from Delhi Main. Reservation Charts for reservations made in respect of passengers originating from Delhi are exhibited on the Reservation Chart Boards. Exhibiting labels on Sectional Coaches which are attached from Delhi is done in advance, and in the case of train service coaches, after the arrival of the train at Delhi Main Station.]

‡PUNJAB GOVERNMENT'S ACTION AGAINST HOARDERS

574. SHRI SURJIT SINGH ATWAL: Will the Minister of COMMERCE be pleased to state:

(a) whether a campaign against the Black Marketers and Hoarders has been started in the Punjab;

(b) if so, how many persons have so far been arrested during this campaign; and

(c) has this campaign resulted in bringing down the prices in the State?

THE MINISTER OF COMMERCE (SHRI MANUBHAI SHAH): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The total number of persons arrested since July 15, when the drive started, till 11th August, 1966, is 1069.

(c) The campaign has, to some extent, eased the situation and resulted in making available consumer articles like wheat, rice, gram, maida, kerosene oil, tubes and tyres and battery cells for torches in the open market.

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI SHAM NATH): (a) Yes.

(b) The work has been started.

CONTRACT SYSTEM FOR HANDLING OF GOODS AND PARCELS ON S. E. RAILWAY

646. SHRI P. K. KUMARAN: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it has been decided to introduce contract system for handling of goods and parcels on S.E. Railway;

(b) if so, what is the number of goods shed and parcel office Hamals rendered surplus and likely to be retrenched; and

(c) what is the amount now spent on these Hamals and what is the saving expected by introducing contract system?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI SHAM NATH): (a) The contract system for handling of goods at certain stations has been in force on S.E. Railway for a long time. It has recently been decided to extend this system to some other stations also where goods/parcel handling is being done by departmental labour.

(b) So far at 4 stations where contract system has recently been introduced, 63 departmental hamals and 51 casual labourers have been rendered surplus. At 5 other stations where the contract system is being extended in the near future the number of casual labourers likely to be rendered surplus is 45. Of the departmental hamals rendered surplus 48 have already been absorbed. Efforts are being made to absorb the balance of departmental hamals as well as casual labourers.

(c) The amount spent on employing labour as per existing arrangements at 4 stations where contract system has recently been introduced and at 5 more stations where it is to be introduced in the near future is Rs. 2,06,574/- and the savings expected at these 9 stations is Rs. 98,074/- per annum.

HOUSE RENT COMPENSATION FOR STAFF OF
WAGON REPAIR SHOP PROJECT AT
RAIPUR

647. SHRI P. K. KUMARAN: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the staff working on the Wagon Repair Shop Project at Raipur, are paid the House Rent Compensation to which the staff at Raipur are entitled; and
(b) if not, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (DR. RAM SUBHAG SINGH): (a) and (b) Staff numbering 25 and working in Wagon Repair Shop at Raipur are not granted House Rent Allowance, since their place of work is not situated within the municipal limits of Raipur.

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (DR. RAM SUBHAG SINGH): (a) No.

SALE OF ADULTERATED GOODS BY KHADI
GRAMODYOG BHAWAN, DELHI

649. SHRI RAM SINGH: Will the Minister of COMMERCE be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that some cases of adulteration have been reported in the goods sold by Khadi Gramodyog Bhawan, Delhi recently; and

(b) if so, what quality control measures are being adopted to ensure that the edible stuff sold by the Bhawan are pure?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE (SHRI M. SHAFI QURESHI): (a) No, Sir. Only in the case of honey sold by the Khadi Gramodyog Bhawan, New Delhi, it has been found in analysis that its reducing sugar content is 55.2% against 60%.

(b) (i) Stocks of honey with Khadi Gramodyog Bhawan have been withheld from sale.

(ii) Steps are being taken to test the honey in accordance with the prescribed standard before it is sold.

(iii) The Khadi and Village Industries Commission is also taking steps to ensure the purity and standard of the other edible products sold by the Bhawan.
