TRIBAL DEVELOPMENT BLOCKS OF MYSORE

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL WELFARE (SHRIMATI MARAGATHAM CHANDRASEKHAR) : (a) to (c) There is no regular Tribal Development Block functioning in Mysore State. However, the requisite information in respect of the two *ad hoc* Tribal Development Blocks functioning in Mysore has been called for from the State Government and will be laid on the Table of the House when received.

INDUSTRIES IN MYSORE
