CHINESE MAPS CLAIMING SKJXIM, BTC.

SHRI J. SIVASHAN-MUGAM PILLAI:

Will the Minisier EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state ;

(a) whether Government are aware that China has published new maps showing Chinese claim on territories *at* SikVim. Bhutan, North East Frontier Agency and parts of Assam;

(b) if so, whether the Government of India lodged a protest with the Government of People's Republic of China; and

(c) what action Government have taken or propose to take to nullify the belligerent attitude on the part of the Chinese Government'.'

THE MINISTER OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SARDAR SWARAN SINGH): (a) Government of India have seen, such press reports but have not come across any Chinese maps which show Sikkim and Bhutan as Chinese territory. Regarding the NEFA area, it is well known that in accordance withi the Chinese Government's ¹ aggressive claims, Chinese maps are showing large area of Indian territory as lying within the Chinese border.

(b) As regards the Chinese claim to NEFA, the Government have in various notes protested and effectively refuted the Chinese contention.

(c) Government of India are taking all necessary steps.
