टेक्नालोजी की भारतीय संस्थाओं के लिए नया पाठ्यक्रम

(ग) क्या इस पाठ्यक्रम के अनुसार इन संस्थाओं में ओनर्स कोर्स की व्यवस्था की जा सकेगी ?

NEW SYLLABUS FOR THE INDIAN INSTITUTES OF TECHNOLOGY

*67. SHRI RAM SAHAJI Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the Institute of Applied Manpower research have suggested a new syllabus

for the Indian Institutes of Technology in one of their published reports;

(b) if so, whether according to their suggestion under-graduate courses in Institutes of Technology at Kharagpur, Bombay, Madras, Kanpur and Delhi would be discontinued; and

(c) whether Humours courses are likely to be provided in these Institutes under this syllabus?!

शिक्षा मंत्री (श्री एम० सी० चागला):

(क) मे (ग) रिपोर्ट में Degree पाठ्यक्रमों के नए आदर्श का सुझाव दिया गया है। फिर भी Indian Institutes of Technology के मौजूदा अंडर ग्रेजुएट कोर्सों को बन्द करने का इरादा नहीं है। Institute of Man Power Research (जन शक्ति अनुसंधान संस्था) के सुझावों को संस्थाओं की Academic Bodies के सामने विचार के लिए रखे जाएंगे।

[THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION (SHRI M. C. CHAGLA): (a) to (c) A new pattern of Degree Courses has been suggested in the report. It is however, not intended to discontinue the present pattern of undergraduate courses offered by the Indian Institutes of Technology. The suggestions made by the Institute of Manpower Research will be placed before the academic bodies of the institutes for their consideration in the first instance.]

* श्री राम सहाय : क्या मैं जान सकूंगा कि इसका विचार कब तक हो पाएगा और मैं यह जानना चाहूंगा कि इसके बारे में आदका स्वयं का क्या खयाल है ?

SHRI M. C. CHAGLA: As I pointed out, I will just say what their main proposals are. They will require consultations not only between the academic bodies of our Indian Institutes of Technology but also the All-India

Council of Technical Education. There are various difficulties in the way. The main proposals are: that the Bachelor of Technology Honours courses should be provided by the Indian Institutes of Technology; that the Bachelor of Technology ordinary degree courses should be provided by the regional colleges; that the Bachelor of Engineering degree courses should be provided in the remaining Engineering Colleges. Their further proposal is—this is very important—only those who have undergone the first two years in the five-year normal engineering course of any of the other Engineering Colleges in the country should be admitted to the special courses to be provided in the Indian Institutes of Technology. In the first instance the difficulty would be this. At present our Institutes are working very well. We have an all-India examination for them and we have produced some of the finest graduates from those institutions. The suggestion is that we should take students from different Engineering Colleges after they have done their course. The standards of different Engineering Colleges are not the same. Therefore, this requires very careful consideration.

SHRI P. C. MITRA: May I know who are the people, and their qualifications, who compose the Institute of Applied Manpower Research, and is it a fact that this Institute

has been filled up by persons in high positions in different Ministries including that of Works and Housing?

SHRI M. C. CHAGLA: It is a very fine Institute which has been doing very good work. It has got a first class Director who is also a member of the Education Commission, and I do not think it is fair to make any suggestions about the personnel of this Institute. They do their best, they make a report; the recommendations may not be acceptable but that does not mean that they do not take a fair and objective view of the question placed before them.
