THE MINISTER OF REHABILITA-TION (SHRI MAHAVIR TYAGI): (a) The total number of old and new migrants from East Pakistan in Uttar Pradesh is about 33,000 persons/7,900 families. Out of these 1,521 new migrant families are in the Rudrapur camp.

(b) 23 persons have been provided with regular employment, while 1,350 persons have been found casual employment. In addition, 115 families comprising 609 persons have been rehabilitated on land. Only 21 persons in the Rudrapur camp are unemployed at present.
