(b) the quantity of sugar exported during the period from January to July, 1965 and the amount of foreign exchange earned therefrom?]

Will the Minister of TRANSPORT be pleased to refer to the answer given to Starred Question No. 12 in the Rajya Sabha on the 3rd May, 1965 and state:

(a) whether Government have since taken any decision on the proposal of M/s Hiltons International to build hotels in India;

(b) whether it is a fact that they have asked for a return of 33½ per cent of gross operating profit from each of the hotels and guarantee of an expenditure of over Rs. 2.5 millions for recurring annual expenditure; and

(c) if so, what are the broad features of the proposal?

THE MINISTER OF TRANSPORT (SHRI RAJ BAHADUR): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) Hiltons proposed that the gross operating profit of a hotel should be divided between the Indian party and Hiltons in the ratio of 2:1. They were to pay the usual taxes on their share of the gross profit before repatriation. Hiltons have not asked for guarantee of an expenditure of over Rs. 2.5 millions for recurring annual expenditure.

(c) The party in the private sector who has applied for collaboration with Hiltons has been asked to negotiate with them and submit its final proposals for the approval of Government.

#### LOANS AGAINST STANDING CROPS

\*145. SHRI SURJIT SINGH ATWAL: Will the Minister of FOOD AND AGRICULTURE be pleased to state the salient features of the pilot scheme to advance short term loans against standing crops?

THE MINISTER OF FOOD AND AGRICULTURE (SHRI C. SUBRAMANIAM): There are no pilot schemes in operation at present to advance short-term loans to farmers against standing crops. In order to augment agricultural credit in areas where the cooperative credit is inadequate, the Food Corporation of India is considering a pilot scheme for two districts, one each in Madras and Orissa for Paddy crop. The project is proposed to be extended to Uttar Pradesh and Punjab later for Wheat crop in the light of the experience gained. The details of the scheme are still being worked out.

#### SEPARATE DEPARTMENT FOR TRIBAL WELFARE

\*146. SHRIMATI DEVAKI GOPIDAS: Will the Minister of SOCIAL SECURITY be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the committee constituted by Government to report on the working of the Special Multi-Purpose Tribal Blocks, headed by the Late Dr. Verrier Elwin, has recommended the separation of Tribal Welfare from the Department dealing with the Welfare of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes; and

(b) if the answer to part (a) above be in the affirmative, what steps Government have taken in the matter?
