THE MINISTER OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (SHRI MATI INDIRA GANDHI): (a) The following feature and documentary films have been entered officially by the Government in the Commonwealth Arts Festival to be held at London:—

EDUCATING MASSES ABOUT FAMILY PLANNING ON RADIO ..

207. **SHRI JAGAT NARAIN:** Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING be pleased to state whether it is a fact that Government are considering a proposal to educate the masses about family planning through radio broadcasts

THE MINISTER OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (SHRIMATI INDIRA GANDHI): Programmes to educate people about family planning have been broadcast from all Stations of All-India Radio since 1959. They are now being increased in view of the recent drive launched by Government to popularise a new device and generally to emphasize the urgent need for family planning in our country.

INDIAN CASUALTIES ON KUTCH BORDER

208. **THAKUR BHANU PRATAP SINGH:** Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to state:

(a) the number of Indian military personnel killed in the recent fighting on the Kutch border; and

(b) the number of Indian military personnel found missing during the military operation on the Kutch border

THE MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SHRI Y. B. CHAVAN): (a) Nine, of whom six were killed in the battle field and three died of wounds received in action.

(b) Nineteen, of whom sixteen were taken prisoners by Pakistan and subsequently released by them on 14-8-1965 on an exchange basis. The remaining three are still on our 'missing' list.

CONSTRUCTION OF A WALL IN FRONT OF INDIAN EMBASSY BUILDING IN JAKARTA

(a) whether it is a fact that a six-foot wall has been constructed in front of the Indian Embassy Building at Jakarta to safeguard it against violent demonstrations; and

(b) if so, at whose instance this wall was constructed and whether the Embassy has borne the expenditure on the construction of the wall?

THE MINISTER OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SARDAR SWARAN SINGH):

(a) The fencing around the Chancery building at Jakarta was replaced by a regular wall. Similarly a wall was also constructed around the compound of the Embassy Residence.

(b) The walls were constructed as a normal measure of protection of property by us and the Government of India have borne the expenditure.
