1. Kenya.
2. Uganda.
3. Zanzibar and Tanganyika (now Tanzania).
4. Ethiopia.
5. Northern Rhodesia (now Zambia).
6. Southern Rhodesia.
7. Madagascar (now Malagasy).
8. Mogadiscio (capital of Somalia).
9. Nyasaland (now Malawi).
10. Mauritius Islands.
