PROPAGATION OF HINDI IN THE NON-HINDI SPEAKING STATES

202. SHRI SITARAM JAIPURIA: Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

(a) the amount of grant given to the non-Hindi speaking States, separately, during the last three years; and

(b) the work done towards propagation of Hindi by the above mentioned States with the said grants?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION (SHRI BHAKT DARSHAN) : (a) The following grants were given to the non-Hindi speaking States under the Central Government's Scheme relating to (1) appointment of Hindi teachers, and (2) opening of Hindi Teachers' Training Colleges during the last three years:—

(b) Under the scheme for the opening of Hindi Teachers' Training Colleges, 9 Colleges and 10 Centres have been opened up to the end of 1964-65 in the various States. So far as the appointments of Hindi teachers are concerned, the number of teachers appointed so far in the various non-Hindi speaking States excluding Kerala till the end of 1964-65 is estimated at 7,128. Information regarding Kerala which is receiving grants under Central Scheme for the appointment of Hindi teachers is not readily available. The States of Jammu and Kashmir and Maharashtra have not so far availed themselves of any grants under this Scheme.
