#### DIESEL OIL FILTERS

♦281. SHRI R. K. BHUWALKA: Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND CHEMICALS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that Diesel Oil Filters, which are used by the Oil and Natural Gas Commission, have been successfully manufactured in India;

(b) whether it is also a fact that same type of Oil Filters are also being imported; and

(c) what is the quantity of Oil Filters consumed by the Oil and Natural Gas Commission annually and the quantity thereof imported and purchased indigenously during the years 1963-64 and 1964-65?

THE MINISTER OF PETROLEUM AND CHEMICALS (SHRI HUMAYUN KABIR) : (a) Out of nearly 15 different types of Diesel Fuel Filters fitted on the engines/equipment used by Oil and Natural Gas Commission, only 2 types have been successfully manufactured in India so far.

(b) No, Sir.

(c) The number consumed annually by Oil and Natural Gas Commission is about 2,000. Of this, the figures for imported and indigenously procured types are as under: —
