HIGH-POWERED TRANSMITTER

Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING be pleased to refer to the reply to Starred Question No. 42 in the Rajya Sabha on the 17th, November, 1964 and state:

- (a) whether negotiations for purchase of high-powered transmitter have since been finalised with any country;
- (b) if so, what is the estimated cost of transmitter; and
- (c) if the answer to part (a) above be in the negative, what are the reasons for the delay?

THE MINISTER OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (SHRIMATI INDIRA GANDHI): (a) to (c) It has since been decided to procure a super high power medium-wave transmitter for All India Radio in addition to the short-wave transmitters. Discussions in regard to this transmitter have taken place with U.S.S.R. There is also the offer from Yugoslavia. We are discussing technical details and the matter will be finalised soon.

As regards procurement of high power short-wave transmitters, an indent has already been placed on the Directorate General, Supplies and Disposals.

RADIO-ACTIVE BUST PARTICLES FOUND IN SNOWFALL IN KASHMIR
