## EXPORT BOARD IN STATES

376. SHRI U. S. DUGAL: Will the Minister of COMMERCE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government propose to establish Export Boards in every State; and
- (b) if so, whether the proposal has been accepted by the different States?

THE MINISTER OF COMMERCE (SHRI MANUBHAI SHAH): (a) and (b) The State Governments were requested to set up an Export Promotion Advisory Board:—

- (i) to advise them in regard to the problems of export trade with respect to the products and commodities being produced in that State;
- (ii) to bring to the notice of the State Government such handicaps as stand in the way of rapid expansion of our exports, and recommend remedies; and
- (iii) to provide a channel for advising the manufacturers, exporters and business community generally, about the export promotion measures undertaken by the Central and State Governments.

Export Promotion Advisory Boards exist at present in the States of Bihar, Mysore and Gujarat and are likely to be set up shortly in West Bengal and Maharashtra. Organisations with similar functions but designated as Export Promotion Advisory Committees exist in Madhya Pradesh, Punjab and Andhra Pradesh.
