(c) whether any compensation will be paid to those parties whose goods have been destroyed in the agitation ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI RAM SUBHAG SINGH): (a) Yes.

(b) As per reports available loss is estimated at about Rs. 65 lakhs.

(c) Under Section 78(c) (ii) of the Indian Railways Act, a Railway Adminis tration is not liable for the loss, destruc tion, damage, deterioration or non-delivery of goods proved by the Railway to have been caused by, or to have arisen from, riots or civil commotion.

For the implementation of this scheme, a new company under the name and style of Precimax Limited was formed.

The manufacture of radial drilling machines will be undertaken in collaboration with a West German firm.
