*378. SHRI R. K. BHUWALKA : Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state :

(a) the names of the countries with which we have diplomatic relations but our envoys have not so far been posted there, and

(b) the time by when Government propose to appoint envoys to those countries where they have not been posted so far ?]

(ख) इस समय कुछ जगह खाली हैं। इन्हें जल्दी भरा जा रहा है।

(b) A few posts are vacant at the moment. These are being filled up expeditiously.]

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRIMATI LAKSHMI N. MENON) : (a) Yes. Sir.

(b) Government have in their notes given to the Chinese Government pointed out that there was absolutely no truth in the Chinese allegations and that the Chinese Government were fabricating these charges for propaganda purposes and for stepping up tension on the Sino-Indian border
